

Frequently Asked Questions

- 1. When do I sign up for swimming/tennis lessons and/or swim team?** An application will come in the mail and you can also sign up at the pool. The signup at the pool is always the first Friday after Forest Hills gets out of school for the summer from **4:30 to 5:30pm** with the lessons starting the following Monday.
- 2. When are the lessons?** The lessons are held in the morning before the pool opens. Swim team is usually from approximately 8:30 to 11:30 am (times vary by division) and lessons are from 11:30am to 1:00 p.m. - 1/2 hour sessions (times vary by age group) 5 days a week. Once Swim Meets are started for the swim team, those days swim lessons are cancelled since the lifeguards are working with the team. Normally meets are on Wednesday.
- 3. What do swim lessons cost?** They are included with your membership.
- 4. What do tennis lessons cost?** \$25.
- 5. What does joining the Swim Team Cost?** \$30 1st child, \$20 2nd, maximum of \$60/family.
- 6. How do I arrange a pool party?** Email the downloadable forms (FHPA | Facilities | Pools) to the Park Secretary to make arrangements.
- 7. When does the pool open?** The pool opens on the Saturday of Memorial Day weekend and closes Labor Day. They start draining the pool on Monday so when the pool becomes to empty, it closes.
- 8. What are the pool hours?** In general, the pool is open for all from 1:00 to 9:00pm, Monday - Friday, through the summer. Saturdays 12:00 to 9:00 and Sundays 1:00 to 9:00pm.
- 9. Where do I pick up my membership information?** The first 2 Saturdays of May are usually “work days” at the park with the third Saturday being a rainout date. You can pick the information up from 10:00 to 1:00 OR at the pancake breakfast on the Saturday morning of Memorial Day weekend. Please pick up your tags OR make arrangements to have someone pick them up for you during the Work Days or Pancake Breakfast.
- 10. What are “work days”?** After your first year of membership, you are given the option of paying the total membership price (\$525) and working two (2) volunteer hours or paying an extra \$30 and not volunteering. Two (2) “man” hours can be 1 hour each by both spouses or 2 hours by either one.
- 11. How do we use the membership tags and guest wristbands?** When you visit the pool, you are required to show the lifeguards your membership tags. Some people have the tags attached to their suits and others keep them on a “pool bag” and show them to the lifeguards when they first walk in. Any guests that are brought to the pool **MUST** wear the wristbands. They may wear them on their wrists or ankles but they must be worn so the lifeguards know they are guests.
- 12. How many guests can I bring?** You are allowed to bring up to 6 guests at a time. However, you are only given 3 wristbands so if you want to bring more than 3 you will have to borrow wristbands from another member.
