

Pool Rules & Guidelines

1. Pool members are to have membership tags available to show lifeguards upon entering the pool. While in the pool area, pool tags are to be kept displayed: clipped to pool bag, towel, or swimsuit.
2. Each member family is allowed six guests at a time. **All guests MUST wear wristbands.**
3. **No adult/child can be a guest if they reside in the Forest Hills Plat** and are eligible for membership in the Park Association.
4. All children, regardless of age, will be allowed into the lap pool. **ALL children UP to the age of 4 will be required to wear a SWIM DIAPER regardless of whether or not they are toilet-trained.**
5. Any small child who cannot swim the width of the pool will **require an adult in the pool with them.**
6. In order to assure adequate Lifeguard coverage and coordinate use of the Community Room, all parties of 6 or more planning to gather at the pool or anyone wanting to use the Community Room must sign up with the Secretary at least two weeks in advance.
7. Running, pushing, and fighting in the pool is prohibited.
8. Smoking is not permitted in the pool area.
9. Alcoholic beverages and glass containers are prohibited in the pool area.
10. In the event of thunder or lightning, the pool will be closed until 30 minutes after the last sign of the storm.
11. During home swim meets the pool will be closed to all members until the conclusion of the meet. Date and times for these meets will be posted online.
